8	February 22	<p>Lecture 1: Wednesday, February 22 (5.00pm-7.00pm)</p> <p>In the Arrupe Program, students acquire the skills and competencies needed to become directors of the Spiritual Exercises of Saint Ignatius of Loyola and spiritual directors in the Ignatian tradition.</p> <p>If completing SGOTE through ACU, some students may begin taking their exercitants through the 19th Annotation before they enrol in the unit so that they have sufficient time to complete the Spiritual Exercises with the exercitant as well as the required Practicum Log and Essay.</p> <p>To complete the Arrupe Program all candidates will, under supervision, guide two retreatants through either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the Retreat in Daily Life over 35 weeks (19th Annotation), or (ii) the full one-month (30-day) experience (20th Annotation). <p>If the student is directing the full one-month experience, it is recommended students receive supervision every second day. If the student is directing the Retreat in Daily Life over 30 weeks, it is recommended students receive supervision on a fortnightly basis.</p> <p>Note: Only those who have undertaken the 20th Annotation will be permitted to take an exercitant through the 20th Annotation.</p> <p>Opening Presentation: Foundations Dr Micheál Loughnane</p>
